Full terms and conditions for 2026 Bindoon Show & Rodeo stallholders.

- 1. Approved stallholders.** We endeavour to respond to stallholder applications within 30 days of receiving a completed application.
- 2. Insurance.** All stallholders must provide their own current Certificate of Currency for Public Liability Insurance to a minimum of \$20,000,000 on application. Applications are not approved until the certificate is received.
- 3. Risk & indemnity.** Stallholders participate at the Bindoon Show at their own risk and are required to indemnify and hold harmless the organisers against any claim for damages, costs, expenses and liabilities including consequential loss and loss of profits in respect of any loss, damage, injury, disease or death caused through any of the stallholder's activities at the Bindoon Show.
- 4. Set-up.** Stallholders have access on Friday 16 October 2026 between 2.00 pm and 6.00 pm, or Saturday 17 October 2026 from 7.00 am to 9.00 am. No vehicles will be given access after 9.00 am on Show Day.
- 5. Cancellations & refunds.** Stall fees will not be refunded if inclement weather or factors beyond the organisers' control affect the event. No refunds will be given for cancellations made less than 21 days prior to the show. No-shows forfeit all fees and may not be offered a site in future years.
- 6. Product exceptions.** For safety reasons no laser pointers, explosive devices or any toy capable of firing a projectile will be permitted on the showgrounds. Grounds staff will inspect merchandise and failure to comply may result in expulsion.
- 7. Site location & assessment.** Bindoon Show organisers reserve the right to change stall locations without notice. Applicants may be refused to maintain the spirit of the event.
- 8. Test and tag.** All electrical leads and appliances must carry a current test-and-tag label. Onsite test-and-tag is available at \$30 per tag.
- 9. Generators.** Personal generators are NOT permitted on-site. BADAS supplies all power.
- 10. Food vendors.** Must hold a valid Food Business Registration and a Temporary Food Permit from the Shire of Chittering.
- 11. Waste & cleanup.** Stallholders are responsible for removing all waste from their site at the end of the event.
- 12. Signage & branding.** Signage must be securely fixed and contained within the allocated footprint.
- 13. Access times.** No vehicle movement permitted between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm on Show Day.
- 14. Rodeo hours.** Rodeo hours are 4.30 pm to 8.00 pm. No vehicle movements are permitted between 2.00 pm and 11.30 pm.
- 15. Band hours.** Band hours are 8.00 pm to late.
- 16. Final instructions.** Successful stallholders receive final instructions approximately 2 weeks prior to the Show.
- 17. Dogs.** No dogs are allowed anywhere on the grounds, including stallholder sites. Competing dogs and assistance dogs are exempt.
- 18. Alcohol.** No BYO alcohol is allowed anywhere on the grounds.
- 19. Smoking.** The Bindoon Show & Rodeo is a non-smoking event, including vapes and e-cigarettes.
